

# Medium Red Clover



**Plant type:** Perennial Legume

**Planting dates:** Jan–April or Aug–Sept

**Soil pH:** 6.0–7.0

**Soil adaption:** Well drained

**Planting depth:** 1/8"–1/4"

**Approximate seeds/lb:** 272,000

**Seeding rate:** 10–12 lbs/A  
2–6 lbs/A mix

**Days to germination:** 7–12

**Main usage:** Pasture, hay, pasture renovation, soil improvement

**Height at maturity:** 24"–36"

**Length of stand:** 1–4 years

**Reproduces by:** Seed

**Pounds per bushel:** 60

**Precautions:** Bloat Potential

Red Clover Alone	8-12
Timothy	4-6
Orchardgrass	4-6
Perennial Ryegrass	4-8
Smooth Bromegrass	6-8
Reed Canarygrass	6-8
Tall Fescue	4-6
