

White Clover



Plant type: Perennial Legume

Planting dates: Feb-April or Aug-Sept

Soil pH: 5.5-7.0

Soil adaption: Wide

Planting depth: 1/8"-1/4"

Main usage: Soil improvement, pasture, wildlife

Precautions: Bloat hazard, slow drying as hay



White Dutch

- Commonly used in lawns as ground cover
- Great for use in plant nurseries between the rows
- Also works in pastures
- Making a comeback as a source of nitrogen in lawn
- Small leaves, low growing
- Available in raw or coated and inoculated
